## Parkland Foundation Update

*Innisfail...* This month, Parkland Foundation releases its 2015 Annual Report, highlighting its achievements over the past year.

The year began with Parkland Foundation entering into a new relationship with The Bethany Group. The Bethany Group has a long history in providing housing for seniors and families in need. Beginning in 1922, the organization has expanded across the province partnering with similar organizations to Parkland Foundation. The Foundation joined a family that includes Camrose & Area Lodge Authority, Flagstaff Regional Housing Group, Lacombe Foundation, Red Deer Housing Authority, and Wetaskiwin & Area Lodge Authority.

Since then, the Board were pleased to announce that the Government of Alberta committed funding for a new lodge and to add capacity to the Foundation's independent living. The new lodge will be built on land next to the existing Autumn Glen Lodge, which will continue to operate during construction.

Construction of the new lodge and additional independent living facilities will be managed by the Government of Alberta. At this time, it is expected that architects will be engaged during the summer with construction to start next year.
